The abstract must be written in English and its extent is limited to one A4 page (25 mm margins). The title of the abstract should be typed using the 14 pt Times New Roman bold font. The names of the authors and their affiliations should be then typed with the 11 pt Times New Roman font using the regular and italic font style, respectively. The title, author names and their affiliations should be centered. Please underline the name of the presenting author. This first paragraph should be for showing what you did and your primary results with less than 150 words using the 11 pt Times New Roman font.

The second paragraph is the body of your abstract. The body of the abstract is typed again using the 11 pt Times New Roman font. The text should be justified. There is one empty line between the first paragraph and the abstract body. In the whole document single line spacing is applied. You may also include equations, tables, figures (see Fig. 1) and references [1]. Equations that are referred to in the text are identified by parenthetical numbers, such as Eq. (1),
